Fire and Floodplains: North Fork Coeur d'Alene River Area

Every summer we see numerous media reports of homes in the woods being threatened by wildfires. Forest fires are a fact of life in the Inland Northwest. Homes located on forested lands (the "wildland urban interface") can be at high risk from forest fires.

Our area around the North Fork experienced forest fires last summer. That got our local Watershed Advisory Group planning for this workshop to help landowners have tools to reduce the risk of damage to your home from wildfire.

With a focus on "Landscaping for Fire Protection," this workshop will help forest homeowners apply practical modifications to their houses and landscapes, making them less likely to burn and easier for firefighters to access.

We'll also talk about the unique conditions found near rivers and on floodplains (aka riparian areas).

Participants will view videos, discuss their wildland fire experiences, and participate in a simple exercise to assess their homes' interface fire risk.
